Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new high school for the growing community in Googong. The new high school will open on Day 1 Term 1 2027. The new high school will include:

- modern classrooms and specialist support classes
- specialist classrooms for science, wood and metal workshops, performing arts and hospitality
- a multipurpose hall for sports and performance, sports and recreation facilities
- a library, canteen, administration facilities and parking.

School naming announcement

We are pleased to confirm that after consultation with the community, Googong High School has been chosen as the official name for the new high school. We thank every member of the community who contributed to the naming of the school. A dedicated school website has also been established and contains all relevant school and enrolment information. The school website is now online and can be visited at googong-h.schools.nsw.gov.au.

Construction progress update

Since our last update in February 2026, significant progress has continued across the project. The concrete structures for all new buildings have now been finished, marking a major construction milestone. Internal fit-out works are underway within Buildings A, B, and C, including the installation of mechanical, electrical and hydraulic services, masonry walls, ceilings, and partition wall framing.

Works have also progressed externally, with bulk earthworks nearing completion and detailed excavations now underway in preparation for landscaping works. Construction of the staff car park is well advanced, while roofing and external façade installation is now underway across the new buildings.

Over the next few months works on the new high school will include:

- The roofs to all buildings will be finished as well as external façade and ongoing internal fit out.
- Landscaping works will start.
- The staff car park will be finished.
- Inground services to Council infrastructure will be connected and public domain works including kiss & drop, accessible parking and bus bays will start.
