100 new public preschools

As part of the plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Government is investing \$769 million to deliver 100 new public preschools, co-located with public primary schools in NSW, to boost access to public preschool across the state. This is the largest investment in public preschools in NSW history, helping more children access a preschool program before starting school.

Project overview

Work is underway to deliver a new public preschool at Queanbeyan South Public School. The new public preschool will provide quality, play-based, intentional educational learning programs guided by the Early Years Learning Framework in a safe and engaging environment for preschool children. The preschool will accommodate up to 40 children per day and include:



2 preschool rooms



an outside play area



administration area and staff kitchen



amenities and storage

Progress summary

We have installed the access control system, new gates and fencing for the preschool and started on the external landscaping works, including planting foliage to compliment the grounds.

The internal fit out of the building has been underway and is nearing completion.

The new public preschool at Queanbeyan South Public School is anticipated to open in Term 3 2026, pending planning and regulatory approvals.

Next steps

In the coming weeks minor works will continue as the project nears completion. These activities will include:

- continue internal fit-out
- Install furniture, fixtures and equipment
- finish landscaping.

Expressions of interest (EOI) to enrol at the new public preschool at Queanbeyan South Public School are open. Families who wish to enrol their child in fee free preschool should submit an EOI to enrol in a NSW public preschool form to our school office. Please note that submitting an EOI does not guarantee a preschool place for your child. Enrolment offers will be made as soon as our preschool is granted service approval, and in line with the enrolment priority outlined in the [public preschool enrolment procedure](#).
